2026-2027 Tuition Fees

The yearly cost to educate a child at TCA is approximately \$7,500. Contributions made by generous donors and fundraisers provide the finances to bridge the gap (after tuition) of about \$3,500 per student. The cost for our families after these scholarships is \$4,000 per year. TCA would like to ask any family that is able to pay the full amount to please do so.

Enrollment Fee (non-refundable):

New students: \$100 per student

Returning Students: Continuous enrollment

Tuition Fees: Tuition Fees can be paid in one lump sum for the year or spread out over 10 months (Aug through May). Payments are due on the 1st of each month beginning Aug 1st.
